**Making Disciples is a two-part process**

**1. P \_\_\_\_\_ aspect: What God does \_\_\_\_\_ us.**

Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind and with all your strength. *(Mark 12:30)*

**2. P \_\_\_\_\_ aspect: What God does \_\_\_\_\_ us.**

The second is this: Love your neighbour as yourself. *(Mark 12:30)*

**"Going Private" - Loving God with:**

**1. A \_\_\_\_\_ Focus (Mature Mind)**

We must pay more careful attention, therefore, to what we have heard, so that we do not drift away." *(Hebrews 2:1)*

**2. A \_\_\_\_\_ Appetite (Mature Strength)**

You need milk, not solid food! ... Solid food is for the mature, who by constant use have trained themselves to distinguish good from evil *(Hebrews 5:12-14)*

**3. A \_\_\_\_\_ Discernment (Mature Emotions)**

Do not be carried away by all kinds of strange teachings. It is good for our hearts to be strengthened by grace, not by ceremonial foods, which are of no value to those who eat them. *(Hebrews 13:9)*

**4. A \_\_\_\_\_ Worship (Mature Soul)**

Therefore, strengthen your feeble arms and weak knees... let us be thankful, and so worship God acceptably with reverence and awe. *(Hebrews 12:12,28)*
